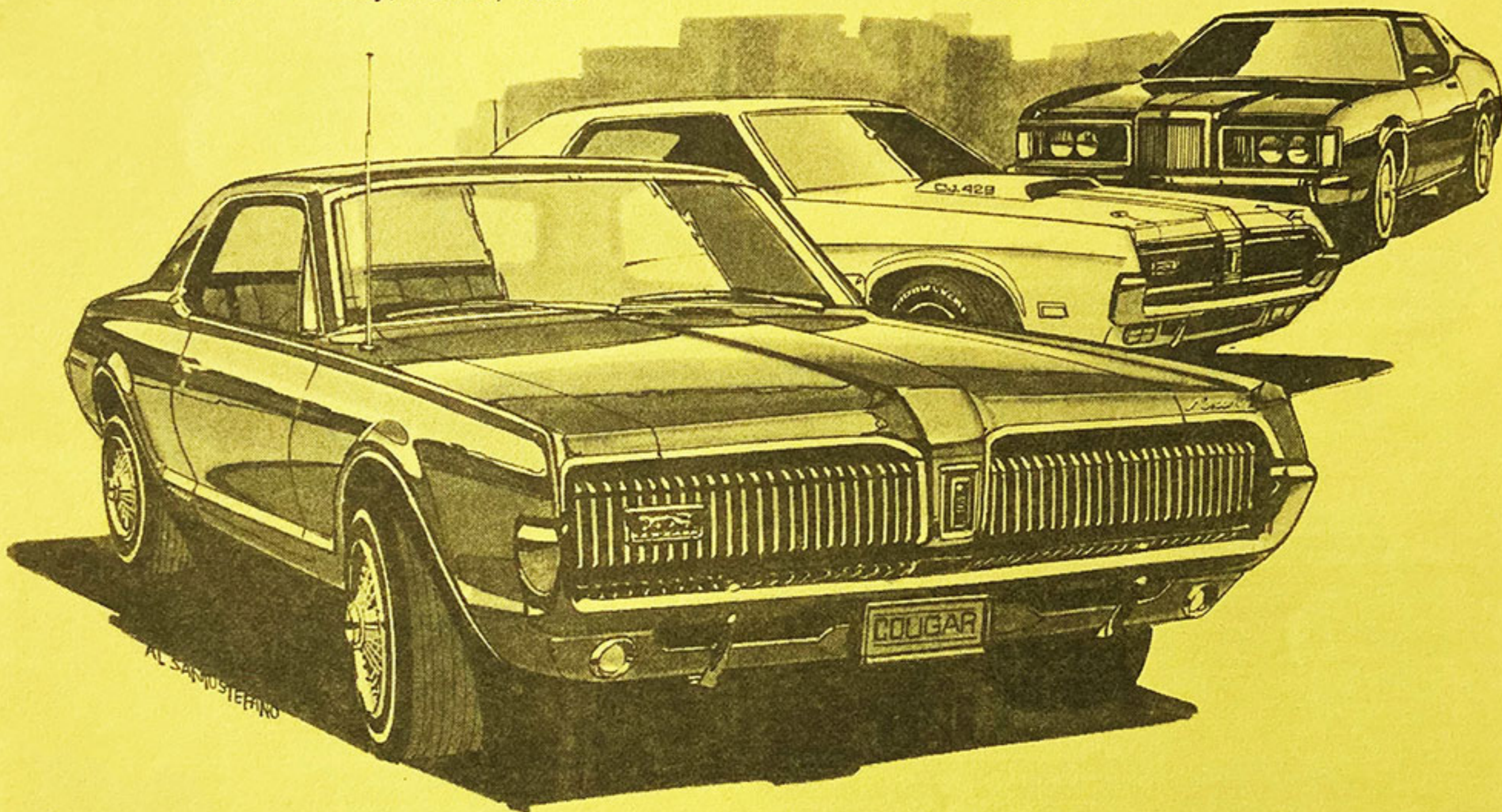

I still don't have a volunteer for the Regional Director for Canada. We need someone from the Canadian region to be responsible for getting information to us too.

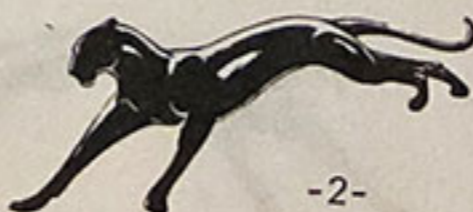

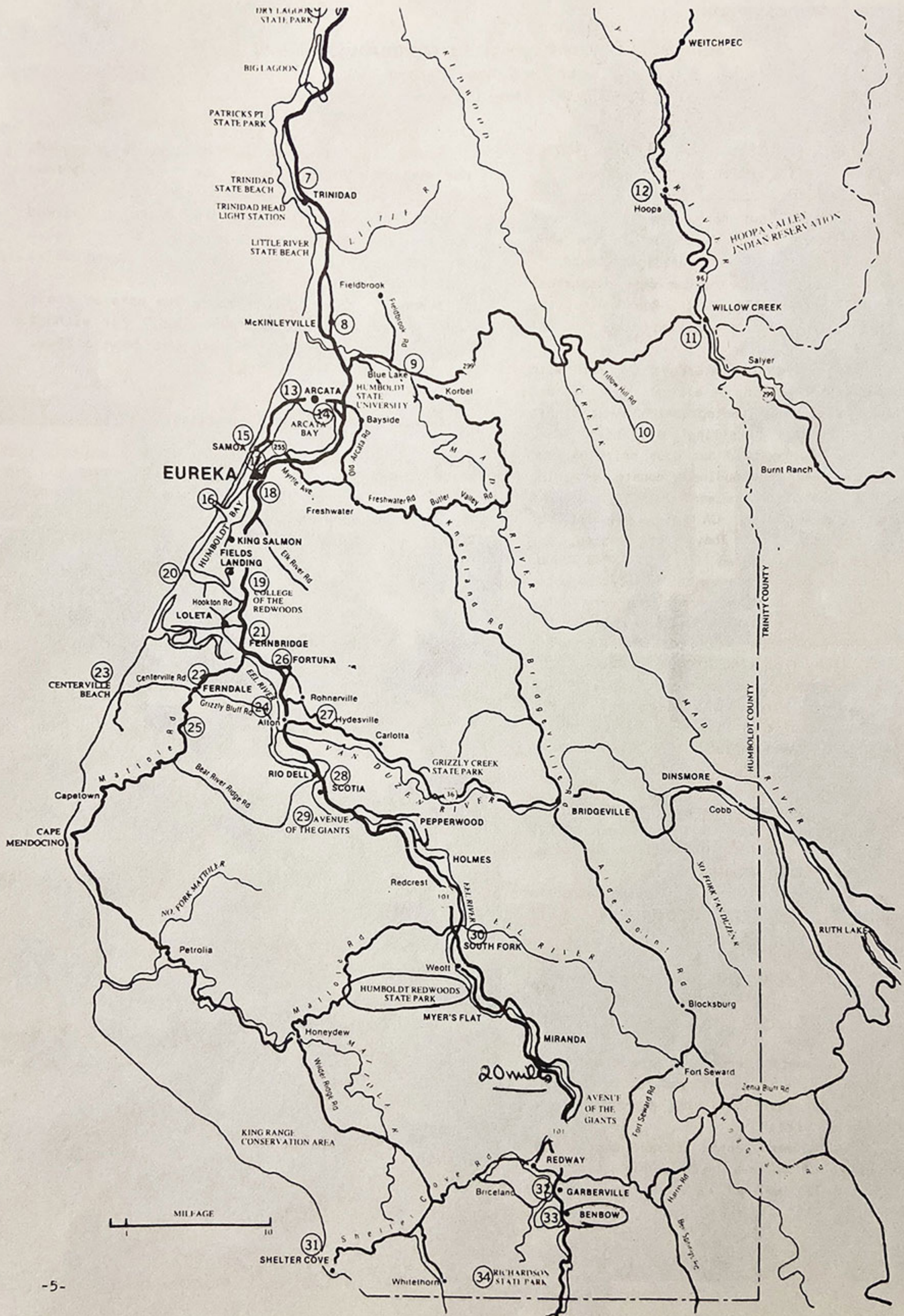

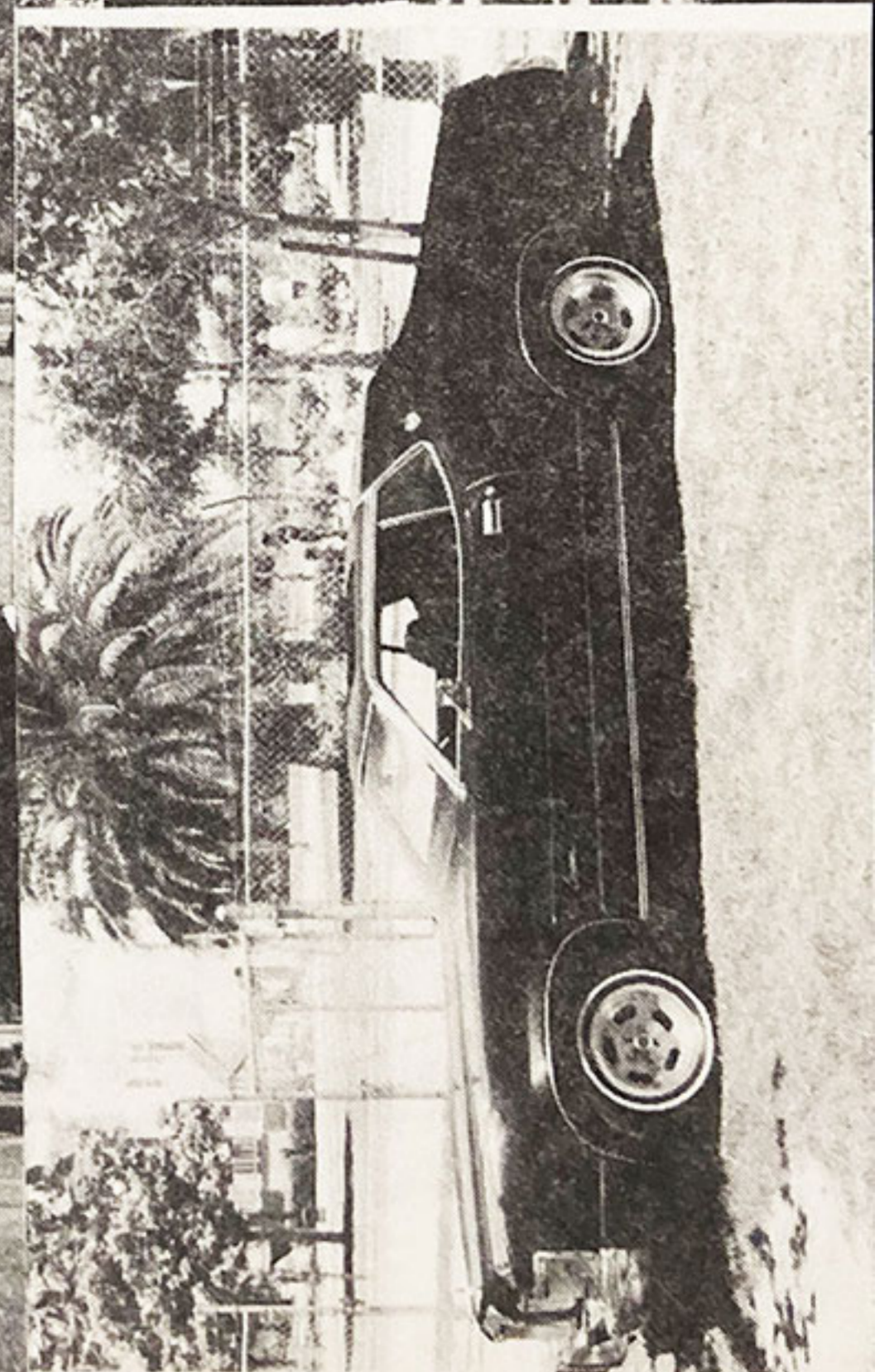

This rate of renewals makes it difficult to plan for the coming years' expenses especially when the newsletter printing and postage is such a significant cost. It was encouraging however, that during 1985 over 350 new members joined the club. Over half of the new members joined as a result of seeing our advertising in national and local magazines. The remaining joined as a result of our members meeting and talking to fellow Cougar owners.

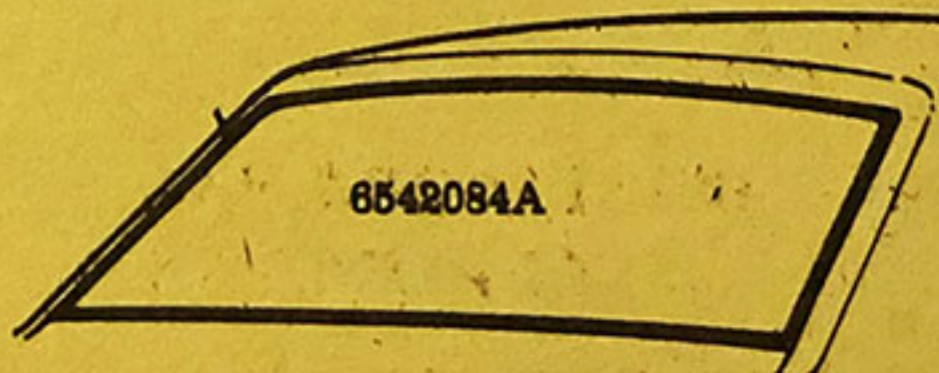
